Feinstein Foundation Donates Funds to Build School in Kenya

Feinstein Leadership Schools of Rhode Island, a public school initiative committed to advancing the importance of community service in education, has donated \$60,000 to Flying Kites for the construction of a school in Kenya. In attendance at the January 10th groundbreaking ceremony, were architects, local Kenyan officials, community members as well as students. The celebration was held in the town of Njabini, South Kinangop region of Kenya.

Construction of this school, the Feinstein Junior Scholars' Academy, has allowed Flying Kites a greater opportunity to educate children from the surrounding community. The two-story building will have four classrooms, restroom facilities, and will include an on-site library. In addition to providing excellent education, the Academy will provide over 32,000 meals for students during the first year in operation. The Academy is scheduled to open in July and will have a capacity of over 80 students. Founded in 1991 by Alan Shawn Feinstein, the Feinstein Foundation is dedicated to the alleviation of hunger, the importance of community service in education and the values of caring, compassion and brotherhood.

Flying Kites, a Newport, Rhode Island based non-profit organization, is devoted to raising the standards of care available to the world's poorest children. Flying Kites operates an orphanage and school for children in central highlands of Kenya committed to providing children the tools they will need to break the cycle of poverty.
